**Eligibility:** All K-12th grade students in New Jersey

**Details:** The Poster Contest has the following themes:

- Careers in Biomedical Research
- Veterinary Advancements: Animal Research Helping Animals

**Awards:** CASH PRIZES

### Essay Contests

**Eligibility:** All 6th -12th grade students in New Jersey

**Details:** The Essay Contest is divided into two separate contests:

**Topics** 6th, 7th & 8th Grade = What is Biomedical Research?  
High School = Biomedical Research and My Life

**Awards:** CASH PRIZES

Learn how biomedical research, including the role of animals in research, leads to new medical treatments and cures.

### Digital Media Contest

**Eligibility:** All 6th -12th grade students in New Jersey

**Theme:** Biomedical Research and My Life

**Details:** All entries must be in a digital media format and no more than 3 minutes. Students may work as individuals or in groups of 2-5.

**Awards:** CASH PRIZES

Recognizes students who digitally demonstrate a connection between biomedical research and their life.
