Digital Media Contest

Eligibility: All 6th -12th grade students in New Jersey

Theme: Biomedical Research and My Life

Details: All entries must be in a digital media format and no more than 3 minutes. Students may work as individuals or in groups of 2-5.

Awards: CASH PRIZES

Recognizes students who digitally demonstrate a connection between biomedical research and their life.
